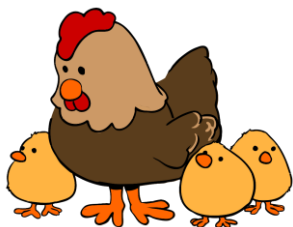
Last year we achieved a 96% overall for the whole school. This year we are aiming for a whole school attendance of 97%. I'm sure you'll agree that we can do it!
