



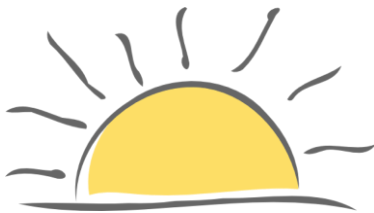
## Newsletter 20<sup>th</sup> April 2018

Please remember school starts at **8:50am**.

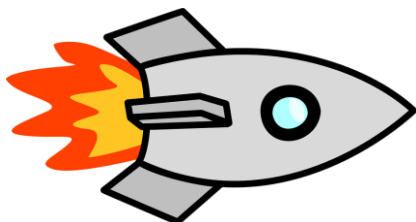
## Curriculum news EY/KS1
